TO: BREWERS AND WHOLESALERS OF BEER
SUBJECT: TAPPING DEVICES (BEER)

The Members of the State Liquor Authority at their meeting on September 29, 1965 considered requests by several brewers for permission to supply tapping devices to retailer for use with the one gallon cans of draught beer.

The determination of the Board with respect to such requests was that such a tapping device may be supplied by brewers and wholesale beer licensees to retail licensees as an adjunct to the sale of such beer provided the device is sold to the retailer at cost and at no profit to the brewer or wholesaler.
