The New York State Liquor Authority (SLA) will host a free training seminar entitled "the ABC's of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Law (ABC)." Scott Wexler, Executive Director of the Empire State Restaurant & Tavern Association (ESRTA), will provide instruction on Wednesday, January 14, 2009 at the Bulger Communication Center at the Buffalo State University's main campus at 9:30 a.m.

The ABC law program was developed by ESRTA with the assistance of the State Liquor Authority to provide owners, managers, and key staff of licensed premises with the information needed to comply with the law.

The three hour session covers every aspect of running a responsible establishment; from issues like amending a license, to maintaining books and records, to price postings and wholesale matters, to preventing underage drinking and sales to intoxicated patrons.
