

Today, the Members of the State Liquor Authority rejected a \$25,000 offer by Scores West to settle a case involving recent charges of prostitution at the bar. In rejecting the offer, the Members offered to accept a license revocation, a two year proscription on the premises, a \$1,000 bond claim and a \$25,000 civil penalty. The rejection of this offer sends a clear message that illegal activities will not be tolerated in licensed establishments.
