TO: WHOLESALERS AND MANUFACTURERS OF LIQUOR, WINE AND BEER
and (NY) MANUFACTURERS-NON-BEVERAGE PERMITTEES
and (BK) BROKER PERMITTEES

SUBJECT: PURCHASE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

Section 99-b, Subd. 1c of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Law provides, in substance, that a manufacturer of non-beverage products may be authorized to purchase alcoholic beverages for such manufacture from wholesalers and manufacturers licensed under the Alcoholic Beverage Control Law of this State.

Please take notice that under no circumstances may such purchases be made from non-licensees; and that alcoholic beverages may not be imported into this State.

All orders for alcoholic beverages by an (NY) Permittee must be placed with a New York State licensed wholesaler or manufacturer. However, when an (NY) Permittee purchases alcoholic beverages from a wholesaler who in turn places the order with an out-of-state manufacturer or wholesaler, the alcoholic beverages may be shipped directly to the premises of the (NY) Permittee from a point out of the State without first being shipped to the wholesaler's premises or warehouse. Such transactions must be billed by the New York Wholesaler and must be duly recorded in the books and records of the wholesaler.
