Subject: Terms of Sale – 2005 Beer and Wine Products Credit Calendar

Chapter 499 of the Laws of 2004 will soon make changes to provisions of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Law governing the terms under which manufacturers and wholesalers of beer and wine products may sell to retailers.

Effective January 1, 2005, ABCL § 101-aaa is amended as follows:

- *first class mail* may now be used by a manufacturer or wholesaler to give written notice of default to licensees not having made payment on or before the final payment date;
- State Liquor Authority publication of the delinquent list ON ITS WEBSITE is considered receipt of the delinquent list by all manufacturers and wholesalers of beer and wine products.

The enumeration of the State's legal holidays, the rules for computing periods of time, and the effect of Saturdays, Sundays, and legal holidays on day-and-date computations are set forth in sections 20, 24, and 25-a of the General Construction Law.

Based upon the amended provisions of ABCL § 101-aaa and the day-and-date computation rules set forth in the General Construction Law, a 2005 Beer and Wine Products Credit Calendar has been prepared and is available on this website.
